Dear Parents/Carers

Update since last newsletter:

- Year 2 had a fabulous time at 'Bring Yer Wellies' last Thursday with lots of great learning involved.
- Year 3 have thoroughly enjoyed watching the chicks hatch over the last few days. Awe and wonder at its best!
- Children and staff had so much fun with the Freddy Fit Sessions in school on Wednesday. Every class took part in a range of exercises to inspire children to keep active and stay healthy. It was great to have Freddy back with us.
- Y6 took part in the South Ribble Commonwealth Baton Relay yesterday. New Longton All Saints did a great handover to us and we passed the baton on to Ashbridge Primary School. Big thanks to South Ribble Sports for organising the event and getting schools involved!
- We have had a 96% response to the Spring Term Parents Evening so thank you for supporting your child. The most common question asked is 'Is there anything I can do to help my child?' The answer without doubt is to encourage reading every night no matter what age your child is. The more a child reads, the more vocabulary they know, the better they can access every area of the curriculum.

Coming up:

- Tomorrow it is the Y5 Extended Outdoor Activities Day to Borwick Hall Outdoor Education Centre -Friday
 18th March. Reminder that children are to wear appropriate clothing for a day in the outdoors tracksuit
 bottoms or similar (not jeans), t-shirt, fleece/jumper, outdoor trainers/boots with a waterproof jacket.
 Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink (the centre will provide snacks and evening
 meal). Children will need to bring a small rucksack containing a complete set of clothes, towel, water bottle
 (no flasks) and a spare plastic bag for wet clothes. Coach will leave prompt at 8am, children are to
 arrive at school 7.45am. Children will be back at school 9pm.
- Reception trip to 'Bring Yer Wellies' Study Trip Tuesday 22nd March (letter issued 9th February). If you have not yet done so, please return the permission slip and make the payment of £14.00 on ParentPay ASAP –thank you! Due to the nature of activities taking place, children are to wear old tracksuit bottoms, <u>school</u> jumper, shirt and tie, wellies (or strong footwear) together with a warm, waterproof jacket or coat. (Please ensure that your child is dressed warmly!)
- Wishing the Girls Football Team Good Luck on **Tuesday 22nd March** as they play their first tournament this year. The girls have trained hard with Miss Fisher and are keen to do well (letter issued to the team Tuesday 15th March).
- Mother's Day Pop Up shop Tuesday 22nd March for Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6 Wednesday 23rd March for R, Y1, Y2

All gifts £2.50. Each class has a designated time to visit the 'shop' during the school day.

- Y6 Residential visit to Tower Wood Wednesday 23rd -Friday 25th March. The children are to wear appropriate clothing for a day in the outdoors tracksuit bottoms or similar (not jeans), t-shirt, fleece/jumper, outdoor trainers/boots with a waterproof jacket. The children will need a packed lunch on the 23rd March, which will be eaten upon arrival at Tower Wood. Promptly after lunch, the children may be taking part in a 'ghyll scramble', which means that they will need a full change of clothes with them (including shoes and a towel) in a separate bag. Tower Wood will provide Wellingtons, Walking Boots, Waterproof Top and Trousers but children can bring their own if they already have them. Coach will leave at 9.30am, children are to arrive at normal school time 8.40am with their luggage labelled!
 Please note that children leave Tower Wood on Friday 25th March at approx 2.15 pm returning back to school approx. 3.40pm
- Y4 Reconciliation Day- **Monday 28th March**. The children will be busy all day preparing for their Reconciliation Service at 2.15pm. Y4 Parents are invited to come along to church at 2.15pm to join in with the Service.
- Y4 study trip to 'Formby Beach and Eco Centre', Southport **Tuesday 29th March**. If you have not yet done so, please make the payment of £19.00 on ParentPay ASAP –thank you! Children need to be in school uniform but need to wear warm jogging bottoms (no jeans) and appropriate footwear for outdoors (walking boots or trainers).
- School Meal Promotion Easter Lunch -Wednesday 30th March. Let the office know by Friday 25th March if you wish for your child to be included (slip was on last weeks newsletter)
- Macmillan Coffee Morning- Wednesday 30th March 10-11am in the School Hall. A group of pupils from Y6 have been busy planning this event and would love it if any parents/ Grandparents would like to pop in for a brew and a cake to support the charity.
