Coming up:

Asymptomatic testing information for parents and adults in households with children at school or college:

Undertaking regular, rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) testing helps reduce transmission of the virus. Parents and other adults in households with children at school or college, who do not have symptoms, can now access regular, rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) testing. This includes childcare and support bubbles.

Tests are fast, easy, and completely free. There are <u>different ways</u> for a household, childcare or support bubble to collect their test to take at home, twice-weekly:

- through your employer if they offer testing to employees
- by collecting a home test kit from a local test site anyone aged 18 or over can collect 1 pack of 7 tests
- by ordering a home test kit online Guidance has been updated to remove: "Do not order online if you can get a test through other methods. This frees up home delivery for those who need it most." This advice has been replaced with: "You can order 1 pack of home test kits containing 7 tests for home delivery. Your tests should arrive within 2 days."

If you have any queries about the tests, please call 119 (free from mobiles and landlines). Lines are open every day from 7am to 11pm.

New variant in Preston:

A new variant of Covid-19 initially found in Liverpool, E484K, has been identified in Preston.

At this time, there is no evidence that this new variant causes more severe illness or is more transmissible.

However, the symptoms of this new variant are more similar to those of a common cold and it is important that anyone who is feeling unwell gets a COVID test: <u>www.gov.uj/get-coronavirus-test</u>
