Coming up:

- **Thursday 19th January** The School Nursing Team will be in school to carry out vision screening tests for children in Reception (letters issued 6th January). This is an **OPT-OUT** system. All children will have vision screening in school unless a reply slip is returned stating that you DO NOT want your child to have vision screening and state the reason for this. Please reply promptly, thank you.

Curriculum for Spring Term:

Please find all the Curriculum Overviews for this term on the website for your information. Every Friday your child's Class Teacher publishes a blog on the Class Page which includes the learning that the class have done that week and the Home Practice that will help to reinforce the learning. Group A Strep and scarlet fever letter to parents and carers:

We have been asked to share the letter attached sent by the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) informing parents and carers of a recent increase in notifications of scarlet fever.

The letter contains advice for parents and carers about scarlet fever and Invasive Group A Strep (iGAS), including what symptoms to look out for and what action to take.

Leave of Absence:

Absences are monitored carefully and **must be applied for by parents**. Parents are expected to arrange family holidays or other absences to coincide with school holidays. In cases where this is impossible, an absence application form must be fully completed and submitted to the school office before any arrangements have been made. <u>If</u> the absence is due to exceptional circumstances and is subsequently authorised by the Headteacher, bookings may then be made.

Absence (Medical/Dental Appointments, etc.) with Appointment Card:

Where possible, appointments are to be made out of school time. However, should you need to take your child out of school for an appointment, please provide school with a copy of the appointment card or letter <u>at least</u> two days in advance of the appointment so the correct codes are recorded for their absence. If an appointment card is not available, please email the school with the details of the appointment. Pupils should be collected from the Reception area near the school office. Please ensure that your child has been 'signed out" on collection. On your child's return to school, pupils must be brought to the school office and, again be 'signed in' by a parent, carer or family member. This is for health and safety and fire regulation purposes to ensure that all pupils are accounted for.
