Letter to parents from the Director of Public Health:

Attached is a letter to parents from Dr Sakthi Karunanithi, Lancashire County Council's Director of Public Health, outlining some of the measures being taken to prevent further spread of Covid-19 in Lancashire's schools and colleges, following a rise in cases across the country.

Schools and colleges are kindly asked to share this with parents to help allay their concerns around some of the action, which is aimed at keeping pupils and staff safe and minimising disruption to education.

We have also attached the school's COVID-19 risk assessment which we review on a regular basis in accordance to the latest government's guidance for schools.

We are still being careful and following our Risk Assessment. Please continue to wear your masks and stick to timings for drop off and pick up. Please leave the premises as soon as you have collected your child.

School Meal Vouchers:

Free School Meal vouchers will be provided for half term from Edenred. If you are entitled (families with children on free school meals who are in receipt of benefits) you will receive an electronic supermarket voucher on Friday 28th May for the value of £15.00 per child (£30.00 for 2 children and £45.00 for 3 children).

Free school meals are provided for all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 classes as part of a Government initiative which began in September 2014. However, for those pupils who have a statutory entitlement to free school meals, i.e. those pupils whose parents/carers are in receipt of the benefits mentioned below, the school can benefit from additional funding called Pupil Premium. This is worth over £1000 per pupil for the school once you have registered your entitlement. The benefit entitlements are:

- Income support or Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, with an annual income of less than £16,190 and not in receipt of Working Tax Credit
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Universal Credit

If you think you meet any of these criteria, we do urge you to register. All you need to do is complete a simple form which is available from the school office or, alternatively, contact LCC on 01772 531809 and provide them with the claimant's (parent's) name, date of birth and National Insurance number and they will be able to confirm over the phone whether or not you are entitled.
