Smart Watches:

Please note that we do not allow children to wear a smart watch to school. Despite the obvious distraction that these devices can pose, smart watches are internet and camera enabled and therefore present the same concerns as mobile phones in terms of safeguarding. Thank you for your understanding.

Threadworms:

We have had a reported case of threadworm in school so please read the following information which has been sent by the School Nursing Team:

Threadworms are common in children and spread easily. You can treat them without seeing a GP. If you think your child may have threadworms, it is important that you treat your child and everyone in the household, even if they do not have symptoms. This is available from your local pharmacy. There are things you can do to stop becoming infected again:

- wash hands and scrub under fingernails particularly before eating, after using the toilet or changing nappies
- encourage children to wash hands regularly
- bathe or shower every morning

- rinse toothbrushes before using them
- keep fingernails short
- wash sleepwear, sheets, towels and soft toys (at a hot temperature)
- disinfect kitchen and bathroom surfaces
- vacuum and dust with a damp cloth
- make sure children wear underwear at night change it in the morning

Do not:

- do not shake clothing or bedding, to prevent eggs landing on other surfaces
- do not share towels or flannels
- do not bite nails or suck thumbs and fingers

If you or your child has threadworms there is no need to stay off nursery, school or work.

Head Lice:

We have also had a reported case of Head Lice. To control the spread of head lice, please check our child's hair over the weekend by using a fine-tooth comb on wet hair looking for insects or eggs. If any are detected, treat head lice on the same day by using a treatment available from pharmacies. You should also check everyone in the house. There is no need to see a GP or keep your child off school.
