ParentPay:

Please note that all ParentPay accounts <u>must</u> be cleared completely by the end of the summer term as debts must not be carried forward to the next academic year. Please ensure, therefore, that your child's account has a zero or positive balance.

ParentPay accounts for Year 6 pupils <u>must not</u> have a negative balance by the end of term. Letters will be sent out next week for any accounts in arrears.

Please contact the school office should you have any queries regarding this matter or in any financial difficulty.

Any ParentPay accounts for Year 6 pupils which have a credit balance and wish to transfer funds to another account or payment item i.e. sibling's account, Early Birds etc., please email the school office. We are in the process of arranging refunds by cheque for Y6 ParentPay accounts which are in credit which you will receive next week.

School Meals Increase:

As from September 2021, we will be increasing the school meal cost to £2.35/meal which is still great value for money. The school kitchen staff do a fantastic job serving healthy lunches every day.

School Meal Vouchers:

For families who are eligible for free school meals and in receipt of benefits, free school meal vouchers have been ordered for the next six weeks for the summer holidays. This voucher is for £90.00 per child / £180.00 2 children etc. If there is any possibility that you may think that you qualify for free school meals, it is really worth checking! The process is easy and all it takes is a phone call! Call the Pupil Access Team at Lancashire County Council on 01772 531809 with your Name, Date of Birth and National Insurance Number.

Qualifying benefits:

If you or your partner receive any of the following benefits you can apply for free school meals:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Guitar lessons with Miss Galea:

Guitar lessons will start in September with Miss Galea for Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5. Letters will be sent home on Friday detailing the information. Places are limited to 8 for each session and will operate on a first come, first served basis. Once the 8 places are filled, we will put children's names on a reserve list and if any places become available, we will contact the first person on the reserve list etc.
