Coming up:

- Harvest Celebration on Friday 8th October in school. Any donations of food for the celebration would be

- Next week is World Mental Health Week and as a school we will be recognising and highlighting the importance of mental health in our Collective Worships and PSHE lessons.
- Reception children are going to visit Longton Library on Thursday 14th October. Please ensure your child
 has a waterproof jacket as we will be walking whatever the weather!
- Tower Wood residential visit from Wednesday 23rd Friday 25th March 2022 for children in Year 6. Please return the permission slip to school asap and a £20.00 non-refundable deposit to be paid through ParentPay no later than **Friday 15**th **October** (letter issued 15th September).
