Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF)– Summer 2025:

Lancashire County Council are issuing families who are in receipt of free school meals with E-vouchers to let them know they are eligible for a place at Holiday Club for their child. This is a way of ensuring all families with eligible children know they can book a place and how to do it, but also that only eligible children or those identified as in need receive a funded place.
