Dear Parents/Carers

Up-date since the last newsletter:

- Due to the number of rising cases throughout the school, we have once again been placed at Tier 2 with Public Health England. We are carrying out all the necessary measures that have been recommended to us and ask that you do not send your child to school if they have any symptoms.
 We currently have the most cases we have ever had as we head into the final week of school so please take care and keep lateral flowing.
- Y6 visited The Museum of Lancashire on Tuesday as part of their history topic 'WW1' The children thoroughly enjoyed the visit and learned so much!
- The Infant Nativity was filmed and put on the website yesterday. All 102 children were exceptional and we do hope you enjoy watching it over and over again!
- A School Calendar has been sent home with your child (one per family) on Wednesday 8th December. If you wish to purchase the calendar, please pay £5.00 to your ParentPay account.
