Coming up:

Sunday 13th March

Sacramental Preparation Mass on at 10.30am for children in Year 4 taking part in the Sacramental Preparation Programme. Parents are requested by Fr Michael to wear masks.

Wednesday 16th March

Freddy Fit Day! Freddy will work with each class on how to keep healthy and active. The day will be funded from our Sport Premium budget and is always informative and great fun for every child. Make sure your child has their PE kit in school for this event!

Wed 16th/Thurs 17th March

Parents Evening. If you have not yet returned your slip to request a telephone appointment, please do so asap. We have attached another copy of the form to this newsletter. Forms are also available from the office. Appointment times have been sent out via the children if you have already sent your form in. Check your child's bag!!

Friday 18th March

Y5 Extended Outdoor Activities Day to Borwick Hall Outdoor Education Centre. Children are to wear appropriate clothing for a day in the outdoors – tracksuit bottoms or similar (not jeans), t-shirt, fleece/jumper, outdoor trainers/boots with a waterproof jacket. **Contrary to the original letter, in order to keep the cost down, children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink** (the centre will provide snacks and evening meal). Children will need to bring a small rucksack containing a complete set of clothes, towel, water bottle (no flasks) and a spare plastic bag for wet clothes. Bus will leave prompt at 8am, children are to arrive at school 7.45am. Children will be back at school 9pm.

Tuesday 22nd March

Reception trip to 'Bring Yer Wellies' Study Trip (letter issued 9th February). If you have not yet done so, please return the permission slip and make the payment of £14.00 on ParentPay ASAP –thank you! Due to the nature of activities taking place, children are to wear old tracksuit bottoms, **school jumper**, **shirt and tie**, wellies (or strong footwear) together with a warm, waterproof jacket or coat. (Please ensure that your child is dressed warmly!)

Looking Ahead- Summer Uniform:

When we return to school on **Tuesday 19th April**, the children are to wear summer uniform:

Girls: Green/white gingham dress, school sweatshirt or sweatshirt cardigan with logo, white socks, black school shoes, green scrunchies, green headbands or green bobbles are allowed.

Let's hope we do have a summer full of sunny days! The field will be in use over lunchtimes in the summer term so mini football tournaments can be played as well as other sports activities. We are so looking forward to inviting you to all the Sports Days!
