COVID Reference Guide for Parents:

Please find attached latest COVID-19 information in the school setting.

Thank you for wearing your face coverings when dropping and collecting your children. This has been most appreciated.

Home Practice:

Every Friday your child's Class Teacher will upload to the Class Page the weekly basic skills tasks that need to be completed. The tasks are designed to be a little and often over the week. Reading is essential for every child every night. We are noticing a greater percentage of children reading every night and this is having a positive impact in the classroom so thank you for taking the time to ensure this is happening. Sumdog participation rates are up this week to an average of 78% so please encourage your child to complete their basic skills challenges.

Home Learning:

If your child is absent from school due to self-isolation, we will provide Home Learning for them as well as their weekly Home Practice. Each class page on the website has a Home Learning link so you can access learning resources as well as collecting a pack from school which will have been prepared for your child within 2 days of the absence starting. We are also preparing if a whole class has to isolate so they can continue to work from home which we know is incredibly tricky for many families.

Harvest Festival:

Thank you for all your donations for our Harvest Festival which the children will be celebrating at their Collective Worships on Monday 5th October. Penwortham Foodbank will collect our donations on Monday afternoon. There will be a box outside the entrance area on Monday for any last minute donations.
