# **COVID Reference Guide for Parents:**

Please find attached latest COVID-19 information in the school setting with updated information highlighted in yellow.

The government has set out the local restriction tier system that will be in place from Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. The current <u>national restriction rules</u> are still in place until 2 December and must be followed until they expire.

### **Reporting a Confirmed Pupil Case of Covid19:**

If your child has been tested, please inform school immediately when you get a test result. If your child's test result is positive, the following information will be required by School:

Child's full Name: Date of Birth: Class: The date/time of when they were tested for COVID-19: The day/time COVID-19 symptoms developed: The day/date that your child last attended School:

Please email if the result is received over the weekend. This is vital if we need to inform staff and pupils who will need to isolate as confirmed close contacts.

### Holiday List 2021/2022:

Please find attached the dates for the next academic year. School will re-open on Tuesday 7th June.

### Free School Meals/ Pupil Premium:

Free school meals are provided for all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 as part of the Government initiative, please may I remind you that for those pupils who have a STATUTORY entitlement to free school meals (those pupils whose parents are in receipt of benefits, such as Income Support, etc.) of the importance to still register for Pupil Premium. School can benefit from additional funding through the Pupil Premium which is worth over £1000 per pupil for the school once registration has been completed, so please check if you are entitled as school benefits greatly! A comprehensive list of the benefit entitlements is listed below and also on the application forms which are available from the trays by the school office. The criteria has changed slightly, therefore if you think that there may be a possibility, please call 01772 531809 to confirm if you are entitled, it's worth doing. Please ensure you have your NI number handy!

- Universal Credit with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, **not** entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work
