Reminders:

Thursday 10th December - Nasal Flu Vaccinations catch up programme: Any children who were isolating or absent on the day of the initial flu vaccination delivery can be included in the catch up programme. If you wish for your child to have the Nasal Flu Vaccination and have not yet not completed a flu consent form, please contact the school office for a form to complete and return to school.

Thursday 10th December - Christmas Raffle: Last day for all raffle ticket stubs and money to be returned to school. The Grand Christmas Draw will take place on Monday 14th December. Deluxe Christmas Day Hamper to be won plus a variety of other excellent prizes. We normally sell the raffle tickets at Booths and at church but this is not possible this year so every ticket sold will make a difference!
