Reminders:

P.E Kit — Your child MUST have a full P.E Kit in school. For Health and Safety reasons, it is important that children are properly dressed for any physical activity. PE Kit listed below and in 'Appendix C' in the School Prospectus:

PE KIT FOR ALL PUPILS	
Gold PE shirt with logo	
Green shorts (stretch shorts for KS1/shadow stripe shorts for KS2)	
Black pumps	

Only pupils in Y5/Y6 may wear trainers.

Green socks are required for cross-country training.

Black jogging bottoms are allowed in winter for outdoor PE.

PE kits should be kept in a named bag in school and returned home for washing every half-term holiday.

Haircuts - Hair must be left its natural colour and severe haircuts are not allowed. Hair ornaments are not considered uniform, e.g. large clips, ornamental headbands, etc. and children will be asked to remove them. **No** number 1 or number 2 haircuts are permitted as stated clearly in our prospectus. National Sleep Help Line:

I know some of you have spoken to me about your worries about your child's lack of sleep so please find attached information that can help parents and children to learn more about their sleep and develop better bedtime routines. As you know, sleep is essential to brain function so by helping children to sleep better, we can help them to thrive better in school.

At any given time up to 40% of adults and 50% of children (this rises to 80% with a SEND diagnosis) have difficulties with their sleep. Yet in a recent survey, almost 60% of adults felt there was a lack of support for sleep issues. Sleep problems often leave people feeling isolated and lonely.

The free helpline is run by trained sleep advisors, many of whom are specialists in working with SEND.

The helpline is open 5 times a week, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday evenings 7-9pm, and Wednesday mornings 9-11am. The number is 03303 530 541.
