#### **School Meal Vouchers:**

We will be processing School Meal Vouchers for the Christmas holidays in the next few weeks for families who are in receipt of the following benefits. For each eligible pupil, a supermarket voucher for £30.00 will be issued to cover the two-week Christmas holiday period.

If your own circumstances have changed and you think you are entitled to free school meals, please contact Pupil Access Team at Lancashire County Council on 01772 531809 with your Name, Date of Birth and National Insurance Number. Alternatively complete the slip attached and we can carry the check out for you!

#### Qualifying benefits:

If you or your partner receive any of the following benefits you can apply for free school meals:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

We're looking for young artists to design this year's Christmas e-card for the Chief Constable.

Budding designers in reception to year six Primary School age groups in Lancashire can enter to be in with a chance of being chosen as the winning design.

This will be used for the Chief Constable's e-card to 5,000 officers and staff as well as partner agencies.

There will be a winner and two runners-up.

The winning artist will receive an arts and crafts goodie bag and a £150 book voucher for their school.

Two runners-up will be selected and receive an arts and craft goodie bag and certificate.

Chief Constable Chris Rowley will personally pick the winning design.

This year's theme is 'how the Police keep us safe' and designs must demonstrate the work the police do to keep people and their property safe over the festive period.

You can enter as an individual.

Everyone has a chance to win, regardless of your age and ability. Be as creative, colourful and imaginative as you'd like!

All entries must be hand-drawn and must be received by the closing date of **Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> November by 12 noon.** Sadly, any entries received after the closing date/time will not be counted.

Twelve shortlisted entries will be put to the public vote via Instagram on **Thursday 1st December.** The chosen 6 from this vote will be presented to the Chief Constable to choose the winners from.

Winners will be announced on the Constabulary's social media channels on **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> December**.

### **Submission of entries**

Entries can be submitted by Twitter or Instagram (not Facebook please). Tweet us, DM us on Instagram or tag us into your creation directly on your Instagram post. Make sure your account is public so we can see your creation.

Find us on Twitter and Instagram via @Lancspolice and use the **#MakeOurChristmasSparkle** when posting your entries.

We also need the following details provided with your entry:

- Name of entrant
- Age of entrant
- Name of parent/guardian who gives permission
- Name of Primary School

Failure to include any of the above details will mean the entry is not valid. By submitting an entry, applicants are confirming that permission has been given by a parent or guardian to the terms and conditions of the competition.

Once you've submitted your entry via social media, please keep hold of the hard copy of your design, as if you're the winner, we may need the original version to help us recreate the electronic version to a high quality.
